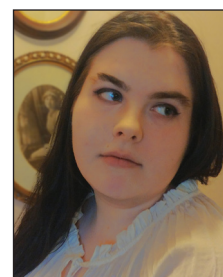

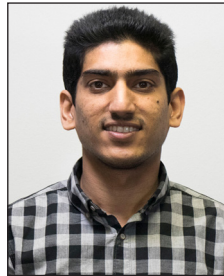

Shocker Pride masks made for library staff/faculty



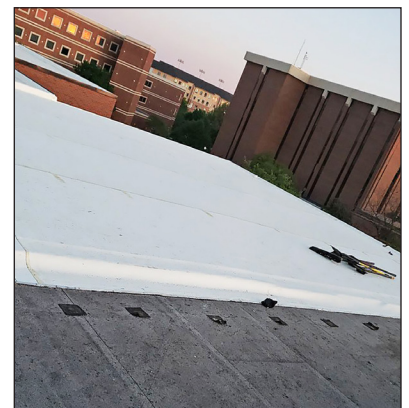
